Some men's sins are open beforehand, going before to judgment; and some men they follow after.





398 Now, we've been through that. If a man can be a sinner and be punished forever...He can't be punished forever 'less he's got Eternal Life. If he's got Eternal Life, he's saved. See? So there's only one type of Eternal Life, and that's the *Zoe*, "the Life of God." And he can't perish.

399 But the wicked are in a place of—of waiting (in torment) for their judgment (to be judged according to the deeds done in the body) at the last day. Now, but we...Some man's sins go before them, some follow after them.

400 Now if we confess our sins, He's just to forgive us, therefore we'll never have to stand the judgment of God. You get it? Look,

Romans 8:1, “There is therefore now no condemnation to them that are in Christ Jesus.” That are IN Christ. That’s passed from death unto Life; see, we have no condemnation and was in Christ Jesus. “That walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.” See? “He that heareth My Words, believeth on Him that sent Me, has Eternal Life.”

401 And if I've been accepted in Christ, and Christ took my judgment, and I accepted His propitiation for my sins, how can God judge me? He's done judged me, when He judged Christ. Then I'm free from judgment. "Then when I see the Blood, I'll pass over you." See?

24 And tonight we're safely, completely resting in the atonement that our Lord made for us, knowing this, that when the judgment comes, that we'll float above the judgment. We'll be taken out of the world and will not have to stand the judgment, for our Lord promised us in Saint John 5:24, "He that heareth My words, and

believeth on Him that sent Me, has Eternal Life, and shall not come into the judgment; but has passed from death unto Life.”

Not a wandering soul when we die; we're in the Presence of God. Not a wandering through a endless eternity, lost, to know we have to return back and be judged according to the deeds done in the body, but, Father, tonight we have settled that at

the altar, and our sins has gone on before us, and been justified by the Blood of Jesus Christ, with the proof of it, God poured back the Holy Spirit upon us, and we're sealed now unto our eternal destination.

325 Now notice, then, Joseph. Before Joseph went forth, they had to sound the trumpet, first. And people screamed, "Bow the knee for Joseph." No matter what a man was doing, he was selling a product on the street,

when that trumpet sound, he bowed his knee. A man was just about ready to reach out and get his money, but he bowed his knee, Joseph was coming. Oh! The m-...the—the—the mimic was just about ready to make his act, and what'd he do? He had to stop. "Joseph is coming." The trumpet sounded.

326 One of these days, everything, even time, will stand still. "When the trumpet

of God shall sound, and the dead in Christ shall rise, and the morning breaks Eternal, bright and fair.” Everything will bow the knee. “Every knee shall bow, and every tongue shall confess to It.”
